



NATIONAL TRANSMISSION PLANNER CHARGES - 1 JULY 2022 TO 30 JUNE 2023

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National Transmission Planner Charges for 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023

The National Electricity Rules were amended in 2020 to re-allocate recovery of AEMO's National Transmission Planner (NTP) costs from Market Customers to Transmission Network Service Providers (TNSPs), commencing from 1 July 2020. The Rules include transitional arrangements allowing AEMO to commence charging TNSPs from 1 January 2021.

The charging of NTP function fees for 2022-23 is based on the GWh consumed in the financial year commencing 1 July 2020 in the relevant region as a proportion of the GWh consumed in all regions in that year.

Table 1 below outlines the revenue requirement for each Transmission Network Service Provider from 1 January 2022 to 30 June 2023.
